Were you able to identify the mystery car last month? It was a Frazer Nash LeMans Replica! Now, before you get your temper up, it is NOT a replica! A little explanation... A wealthy wool merchant from Scotland purchased a competition model Frazer Nash and entered it in the Lemans race post war.



He co-drove the car with Archie Frazer-Nash (The name Frazer-Nash has a dash; the car Frazer Nash does not) and finished a respectable ninth. From that point on, cars built to those specifications were called Lemans Replicas. Frazer Nash also had a body style much like an MG A as well as others. They were never mass produced so they are rare. The Frazer Nash cars I put on the website for you to ID were pre-war cars: chain drive with solid rear axle, no differential. This FN is post-war when they built regular sports cars. They also had an association with BMW that I could never quite

figure out.



Here is this month's car. This is quite rare but if you do a little looking, you should be able to ID it. 'Can't give you any clues so GO FOR IT!


