Date: Tuesday, 8/16/23


Time: 3:00 – 9:00 PM

What We've Been Up To!



BCC Tech Session

Our BCC Tech Session took place July 11th at Valerie Oleksik's house. Several members (and Stella the dog) came to help troubleshoot and brainstorm the problem with ailing Morris the Mini. Valerie gave a run down of what happened with her Mini the day it broke down. She was informed it was probably a head gasket.



George brought a pressure tester for the water system to test for leaks between the cylin-

ders which turned out negative. Randy brought a compression tester and all cylinders tested good for compression. This indicated the head gasket was good.





The group inspected the Mini's electrical system and found a corroded rotor and an improperly fitting cap.

After cleaning the rotor and cap, starting fluid would temporarily run the car but the carburetor's float chamber was starving for fuel. We removed the carburetor, disassembled it and found it had the wrong gaskets on the float bowl. The carburetor was reinstalled and the car ran for 5 minutes before it stalled out. New gaskets for the float bowl have been

ordered and we will go from there. In an email, Valerie gave a big thanks to all who joined in to take part in this group effort: "I am so grateful to everyone who came out to help! The sup-


