

On Sunday, September 17, 2023, the Toronto Triumph Club is hosting the 38<sup>th</sup> British Car Day®, the largest, one-day, all-British car event in North America. It will be held in Bronte Creek Provincial Park, about 25 miles west of downtown Toronto, at the Burloak Drive exit off the Queen Elizabeth Way. The event draws around 1,100 vehicles and over 9,000 spectators and is open to vintage, classic and current British manufactured vehicles, including motorcycles.

This is from the estate of the late Bob Schiffhaure who was a member of the British Car Club, NEMGTR, and others. He was restoring a TD when he passed away and these are all items in his garage. If you are interested in anything you may contact myself or his son Bob Schiffhaure. I'll put the phone numbers at the bottom.

Spent a few hours there today and here are some items: TD steering rack, wiper motor, voltage regulator (used I think) aluminum valve cover and matching side plate, BRAND NEW GRILL SHELL with the nose cap and badge, Windscreen parts like the posts on each end and some other hardware, seat cushions with the adjustable tracks as well as one back cushion. The upholstery is no good. Rear quarter panels both L & R. running boards, double bubble cowl, petrol tank end panels, ignition & horn switch side panels from scuttle back, two radiators, used, pair of headlights that appear new could be replated, plus several other lights, A complete hood all 4 pieces (bonnet) a gear box in pieces, and numerous pieces of rubber parts and a drawer full of electrical goodies.
